Induction & training workshop - Stockton Beach 21-23 March 2016

"Learn, Share, Connect"

This workshop is designed to increase skills and build partnerships for the delivery of the Local Landcare Coordinator Initiative.

Purpose

This is an important opportunity to learn about what's expected from the Coordinators and their hosts, to develop stronger Landcare Networks, and to build upon the partnership between Landcare and Local Land Services. We also want you to contribute your ideas to the Initiative.

The diversity of Landcare across NSW is rich, but the commonalities and linkages are also numerous; this is an opportunity to find out about what is happening across NSW, meet people often dealing with similar issues and challenges, and be part of a state-wide community working in and with Landcare and Local Land Services.

The workshop will offer the opportunity to:

- Learn about the program and contribute to building its value and legacy;
- Understand the requirements of the program for host organisations and Coordinators;
- Undertake training to build the capacity of your group or network;

Share ideas, tools and experience; and

Network to build regional and State-wide relationships.

Process

The workshop will have many different formats such as small group sessions, interactive training, Q&A sessions, plenary talks and team building.

We will also be asking host organisations to complete a training needs survey so the program can be tailored to best meet your requirements.

The program will kick-off at 2:30pm on the afternoon of Monday 21st and finish at 12:30pm on Wednesday 23rd, allowing for travel time on those days.

Attendees include Coordinators and a representative from their hosting organisations, RLFs, and Community Engagement staff from Local Land Service regions. (Note it is a contractual requirement that all Coordinators employed under the Local Landcare Coordinator Initiative and a representative from their host organisation attend this workshop).

Forum costs, including accommodation (twin share) and meals are covered for each Local Landcare Coordinator and the representative from each host organisation. Other participants will contribute on a cost recovery basis. Travel arrangements and travel costs to and from the event are the responsibility of all attendees.

By Public Transport

Limited stops trains depart Central (Sydney) hourly eg 8:15am (arrive Hamilton, Newcastle 10:47); 9:15am (arr 11:46); 10:15am (arr 12:47); 11:15am (arr 13:46). A short bus and ferry trip completes the journey to Stockton. Dependent on numbers a direct transfer may be organised from Hamilton.

A number of coach services operate between Sydney and Brisbane and other major centres, stopping in the Newcastle region.
