Role Title: South East Regional Landcare Coordinator

The position will report to a steering committee representing Landcare networks in the South East region.

The South East Regional Landcare Committee is seeking an enthusiastic and highly motivated individual who can connect and support a thriving Landcare community in the South East region of NSW. Join a community of practice for Landcare supporting 14 Networks, over 300 groups and more than 3000 volunteers in the region working towards biodiversity, sustainable agriculture and community resilience outcomes.

The Regional Landcare Coordinator role is hosted by the Far South Coast Landcare Association. The role will work closely with the South East Regional Landcare Committee, part-time Landcare Coordinators in the South East region, Landcare NSW, South East Local Land Services and Local Government among other relevant organisations.

Landcare in the South East region has a strong history of collaboration and mutuality. This role will play an important part in maintaining an ethos of 'stronger together' in relationships within Landcare and between Landcare organisations and partners.

The position is a component of the NSW Landcare Program 2019-2023 funded by the NSW State Government.

- Support planning, collaboration, regional organisation, and capacity building for more effective participation in large scale opportunities
- Coordinate and support the South East Regional Landcare Community of Practice
- Identify and build network, partnership and new funding opportunities for Landcare in the South East

- Strengthen the work of Coordinators through liaison and support structures
- Build on the relationship with South East Local Land Services, Local Government and relevant agencies at the regional scale
- Link Landcare to business and community groups through joint activities

- Ability to work with volunteers, other professionals and government
- Experience in a relevant field such as environmental management, land management, sustainable agriculture or community resilience
- Skills/experience in project management and coordinating events
